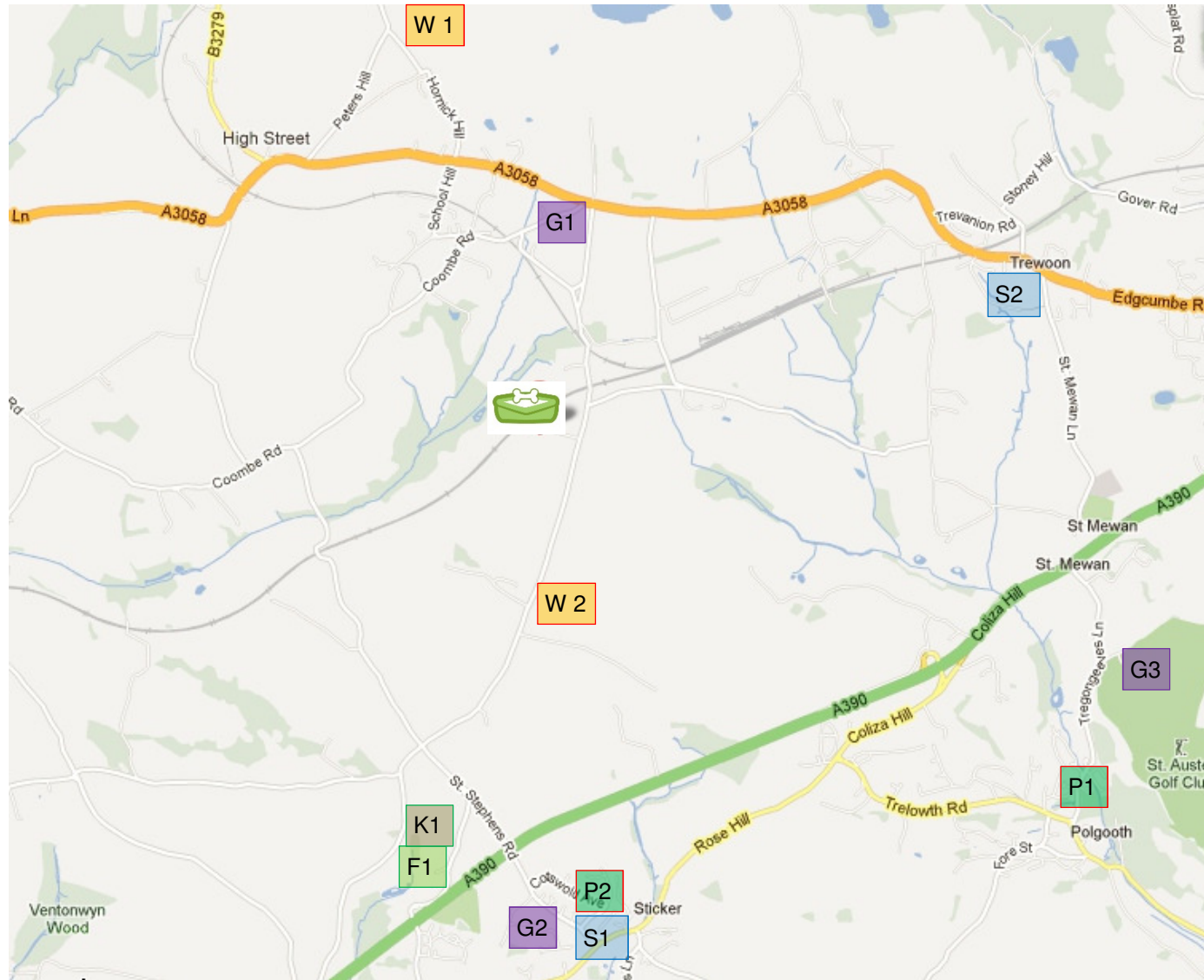

## Guide to dog-friendly activities

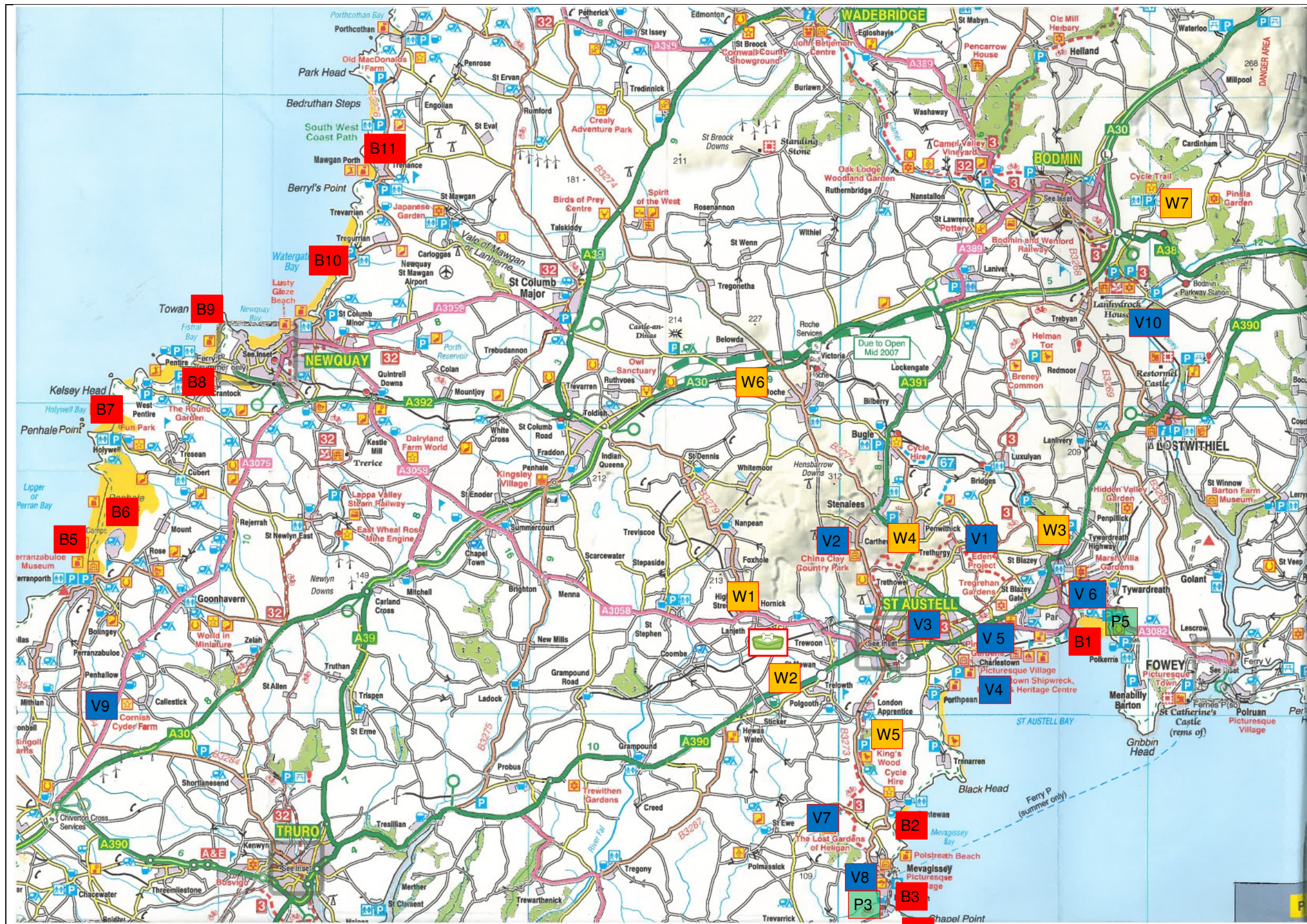

**Beaches - B**  
 Beaches with all year round dog access – unless noted. Postcodes are approximate!

B1- Par PL24 2AS  
 Wide, flat and sandy with free parking out of season and after 5 pm in season.

B2 - Polstreath beach - PL26 6TH  
 10 minute walk and long steep steps to beach so usually deserted

B3 - Portmellon PL26 6PX  
 Small sandy beach. Very steep path down

B4 – Vault beach (just off this map).  
 Park at Gorran Haven (possibly PL26 6JF). Gorran Haven beach is very small and is not dog friendly. Vault beach is about 20 minutes' walk south along coastal path. Beach is large, sandy and dog-friendly.

The following beaches are on the north coast which is only 25 – 40 minutes' drive away.

B5 - Perranporth TR6 0JL  
 Car park, cafes, toilets by very large sandy beach. Dogs must be kept on leads near car park in the summer 9am to 5pm. Ok off lead when away from car park (signs on the beach to say when ok).

B6 - Penhale Sands TR6 0AQ  
 Large sandy beach. Access via campsite or Perranporth beach.

B7 - Holywell bay TR8 5PP  
 Large sandy beach after sand dunes. Car park.

B8 - Crantock TR8 5SA  
 Large, sandy beach with dunes at the mouth of the River Gannel. Car park.

B9 - Fistral TR7 1EW  
 Large sandy surfing beach, car park, and cafe nearby.

B10 - Watergate bay - TR8 4AA  
 Large sandy beach. Nice café and pub. Jamie Oliver's 15 to 1 is there.

B11 - Mawgan Porth TR8 4BA  
 Sandy beach, large when tide is out. Merrymoor Inn is dog friendly with good food.

**Walks - W**  
 W1 & W2- See local page; overleaf

W3 - Luxulyan Valley – PL24 2RR (approx.)  
 Extensive walks through woods and historic mining area. Car park at the end of Ponto Mill Road off the A390. Go through St Blazey, over railway level crossing. When going uphill, turn left between 2 white cottages with blue Ponto Mill sign.

W4 - Old Baal Clay Pit Carclaze PL26 8XZ (approx.)  
 Turn off the A391 at a roundabout towards Trethurgy, and there is a lay-by on the left.

W5 - Kingswood near Mevagissey PL26 7AP (approx.)  
 Walk through woods. Dog friendly café and pub at end of trail in Pentewen village.

W6 – A30 at Roche PL26 8LQ (approx.)  
 Scenic walk along a disused part of the old A30 near Roche

W7 - Cardinham woods near Bodmin. PL30 4AL  
 Woods with extensive walks.

There are also lots of coastal walks, e.g. near Mevagissey and Looe

**Visitor attractions – V**  
 V1 - The Eden project PL24 2SG Dogs on leads  
 V2 - China clay museum PL26 8XG Dogs on leads  
 V3 - St Austell brewery PL26 8XG No dogs  
 V4 - Charlestown Shipwreck & Heritage Centre PL25 3NJ Dogs on leads  
 V5 - Pinetum Park - PL25 3RQ Largest collection of plants in the county. Over 30 acres. Dogs on leads.  
 V6 - Marsh villa gardens - PL24 2LU 3-acre water and woodland garden. Dog on leads within the garden.

V7 - Lost Gardens of Heligan PL26 6EN Dogs on leads.  
 V8 - Mevagissey Lovely village with a fishing port. Dogs on leads around village, not on beach. Recommend Sharks Fin restaurant on the quay 01726 842969  
 V9 – Healey's cyder farm TR4 9LW Dogs on leads  
 V10 - Lanhydrock house – National Trust PL30 5AD. Dogs on leads. Often sheep roaming
